Brief Report on Walk with a Scholar (WWS) Programme at Sree Narayana College, Kannur



The department also conduct three different certificate courses on Mushroom cultivation, Fermented foods and Biofertilizer production.









Solar ambassador programme

Workshop Overview:

The Student Solar Ambassador Workshop was organized on 3rd October 2019 at S N College Kannur as part of a global initiative led by IIT Mumbai. This workshop was a segment of the Gandhi Global Solar Yatra, a movement aimed at promoting Energy Swaraj—the concept of localized energy self-sufficiency. It aimed to raise awareness among the youth regarding the critical need for renewable energy sources, particularly solar energy, to mitigate the effects of climate change. The workshop also marked the 150th Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. Similar workshops were held in over 100 countries, with an estimated 3 million students globally participating in this event, building their own solar study lamps. These hands-on activities focused on educating students about solar energy technology and its benefits. Students were given a **solar lamp kit** and provided with hands-on training on how to assemble it and upon successfully assembling their lamps, they were awarded a **Course Completion Certificate** by **IIT Mumbai**.

About the Workshop

In the wake of energy sustainability and mitigating climate change, the idea of "Energy Swaraj" or localized energy self-sufficiency has been conceptualised as a global movement. Gandhi Global Solar Yatra is planned by IIT Mumbai not only in India but across the globe to sensitize the young minds towards solar energy and dire consequences of climate change.
