PURULIA CHHAU

Chhau dance is a genre of Indian tribal martial dance popular in Indian States of Odisha, Jharkhand and West Bengal. Based on the places of its origin and development, is called SeraikelaChhau, MayurbhanjChhau & PuruliaChhau.

Also called paikannutya. The word "paika" is derived from the Sanskrit word Padatika meaning the infantry, hence the name of the dance is battle (paika) dance (nutya). Some believe that the word Chhau is derived from Sanskrit Chaya (shadow, image or mask), but according to SitakantMahapatra, it is derived from Chhauni (military camp).

The most prominent difference among the three sub-genres emerges from the use of masks. SeraikelaChhau uses smaller masks, PuruliaChhau uses large and colourful masks and MayurbhanjChhau uses none at all. Instead, the artists paint their faces.

Chhau dance is mainly performed during regional festivals, especially the spring festival of Chaitra Parva which lasts for 13 days, in which the whole community participates.

Chhau blends within it forms of both dances and martial practices employing mock combat techniques (called khol), stylised games of birds and animals (called chals&stopkas) and movement based on the chores of village housewives (called ulis).

It is performed by male dancers from families of traditional artists or from local communities and is performed at night in an open space, called an akhada or asar, to traditional folk music played on reed pipes – mohuri&shehnai. A variety of drums accompany the music ensemble including the dhol (a cylindrical drum), dhamsa (a large kettle drum) and kharka or chad-chadi.

The themes for these dances include local legends, folklore, episodes from the Ramayana & Mahabharatha and other abstract themes.



The working president Shri. Suresh Babu M K welcomed the gathering and narrated previous activities as follows:

1. Institutional Alumni "Honored the Meritorious Students who secured the first & second position in 13 subjects at present existing at Sree Narayana College, Kannur.
2. Conducted the prestigious SPC MACAY program (PULUJA CHERAU-Bangali folk Art) at college campus.
3. A Western Music Group was formed at Sree Narayana College, Kannur at Institutional Alumni's initiative. It selected, trained them and taken to the location where University Arts Festival was conducted by arranging transportation and food. The Western Group won the third position in the event.
4. Institutional Alumni actively participated in student assistance program to support Ms. Anusree N, the recipient of the Marie-Curie Fellowship, is from a low-income group family. Her teachers informed us that she finds it difficult to meet the preliminary expenses for traveling abroad along with flight ticket expenses. Hence, we thought of seeking financial assistance from her well-wishers. The faculties of her department contributed Rs.25,000.00. The Physics 2017, 1981 & 1982 batch contributed good amounts for this purpose. After hearing about this number of persons from Physics 1964 batch to 2020 batch contributed amounts. But the exiting part of this is that, when we informed in group that Anusree is planning to carry her secondhand lap top to Greece one person who don't want to disclose his name from Physics 1982 batch arranged to purchase a new lap top with configuration which suits for her purpose.

After this working President invited Dr. N Sejan to present his views on organizing a global Alumni meet.

He narrated that, we will project the idea of "Student Support & Progression" and fine start from UAE chapter then extends to USA, Canada, UK, Australia, New Zealand etc. We have to propagate

that "We Expect Goodwill Not Money". With this a project has to be launched, which will extend for one or two years. A consolidation to be happened by re-orientation of Department Alumni and by integrating it globally.

Mr. Ajaykumar pointed out that the need of the hour is an orientation program on 4-year graduation to Plus 2 pass out students before the admission process starts, preferably before May end. Which has to cover areas like which subject to opt and the steps to be followed for successful completion of course.

Regarding Global Alumni meet he suggested to conduct a physical meeting to short out ideas by step progression of reaching gradually. Because its not easy to reach the well-placed Alumni.

Dr. Prasad touched the area of NAAC accreditation present status. NAAC to be prepared before by the end of July. NAAC team is expected to visit our College in June. Hence something has to be done by Alumni on infrastructure. INSTITUTIONAL Alumni has to focus on "Industry-Institute-Interaction". Because our college is far behind in areas like Mentorship & Entrepreneurship. Community outreach programs and financial support. He concluded that this is the right time to conduct a signature program.

He has further requested that, the fresh students to be addressed by SNCKIAA and FLUOR programs to be conducted from state onwards. A constructive support to be given to prospective students coming under FLUOR.

Mr. Mahesh Balga proposed to conduct a Job fair at College. He pointed out that the industries in Kannur area complain about non availability of meritorious students from Kannur.

Mr. LATHI stressed on 4-year MS programs to be conducted by inviting prospective students and parents by visiting various educational institutions in and around Kannur.

Global Alumni has to be conducted by allocating duties to various categories of Alumni, Teaching and non-teaching staff.

Mr. Suresh Mathan supported Mr. Lathi's suggestions on FLUOR. Regarding Global Alumni meet he suggested to invite well placed Alumni and conduct an online meeting of Globally reputed Alumni before having a state for Global Alumni Meet.

A calendar to be prepared for future programs.

Accounts and Papers to be prepared from March 2023 to February 2024 in a General Body meeting because it is mandatory and statutory.

Dr. Sathya raised the point as the College has any idea about their year wise students placed in society? The "E N Kannur Issues", the well-referred personalities to be searched and to be brought in from India. The platform should be used for constructive and COIC programs. If sustainable programs conducted students will be benefited out of it. Programs should be conducted with vision not just for the sake of doing it.

Mrs. Jayashra supported the Global Alumni Meet and extended her support in finding the E N Kannur jobs originated from their department.

Dr. R. Sajan proposed vote of thanks and meeting concluded by 9:00 pm.
