


JOURNEY THROUGH THE NATURE

ENVIRONMENTAL VISIT AT KAREEM'S FOREST ON 03/02/24 – A BRIEF REPORT

This beautiful forest park is in 32 acres which was converted from a barren waste land into a dense forest since last 40 years. The park is situated at Puliyaikulam near Parappa. Kareem, native of Kasargod is behind this green venture. The forest park is a remarkable example of forest conservation. Similar to other natural forest, Kareem's forest is rich with a variety of plants and shrubs. It also gives shelter to innumerable species of birds, small wild animals and medicinal plants. The forest that we visited is very rich in flora and fauna. This land is known for its beautiful natural surroundings. The forest maker protects different varieties of forest trees, medicinal plants, grasses, birds, orchids, butterflies, edible plant roots. The forest holds wide varieties of wild flowers, fruits, small wild animals and rich in ecosystem. We got pure natural drinking water during the forest visit. The forest maker, Abdul Kareem explained several features of the forest and we understood many new things. He also shared his journey of this forest making. It was from Dubai that he got the idea to create a forest. He left his flourishing business and come back with an unusual dream to make a forest. But the locals scoffed at his dream. Because it was hard to plant saplings in that rocky surface. But he took the initiative and courage to fulfill his wild dream. It was not an easy journey. Now the forest is frequented by people from different walks of life, environmentalists, scientists, university and Ayurveda students and layman for practical experience and study purposes. We heard that the seeds and saplings of this forest trees and medicinal plants were also multiplying and distributing. During this age of fresh water scarcity this forest acts as a reservoir of water. In this forest visit we have seen different kinds of plants, medicinal plants, shrubs, herbs, climbers etc. which were new to us. In fact, this forest visit was very useful to us for gaining more knowledge related to forest surroundings. This trip not only offered a glimpse into the natural wonders but also fostered a deep appreciation for environmental conservation. The picturesque surroundings and the guidance of our faculty made this excursion truly memorable.
